Burial will be in West Park Cemetery in Cleveland.



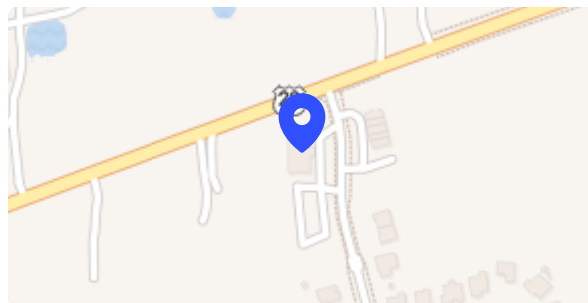

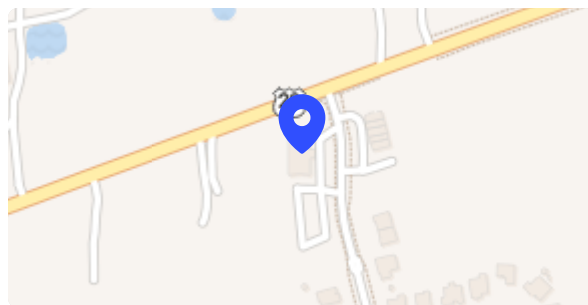

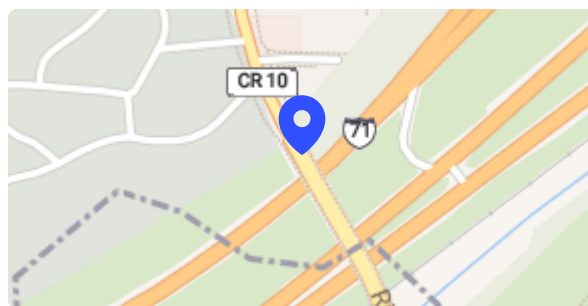
