Linda Gail Shultz (nee Davis), age 66, of Parma, passed away surrounded by her family at Seasons of Life Hospice Residential Center in Parma, on November 22, 2014 after a lengthy illness.

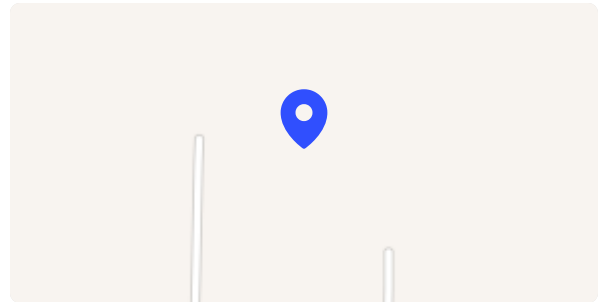

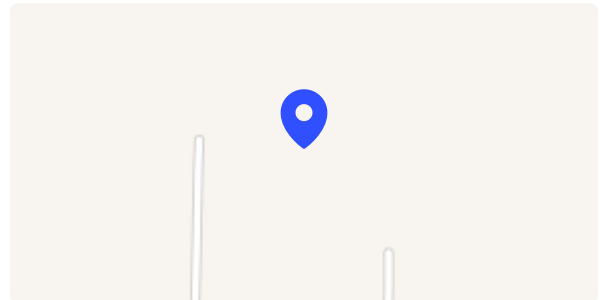
