In lieu of flowers, memorial contributions may be made to a charity of the donor's choice.



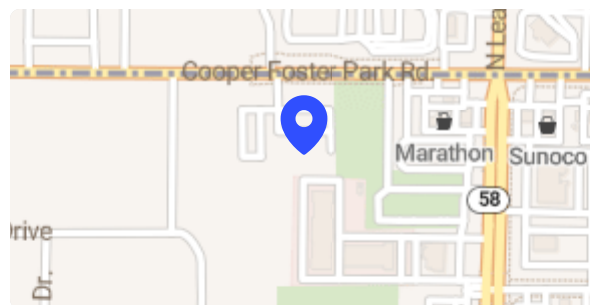

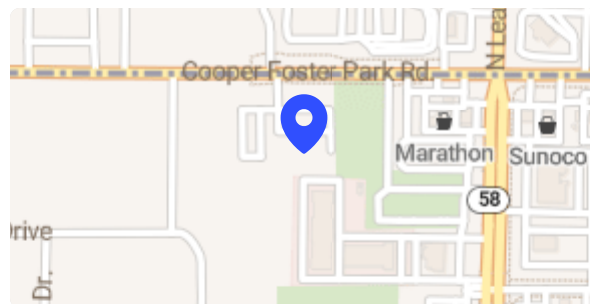

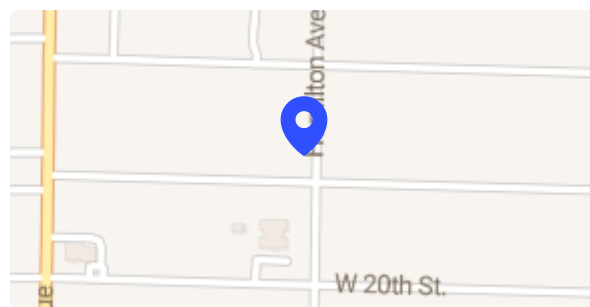
