Ann H. Tompkins (nee Haralampous), age 76, of Elyria, passed away on Friday, January 16, 2015 at New Life Hospice Residential Center in Lorain, following a short illness.

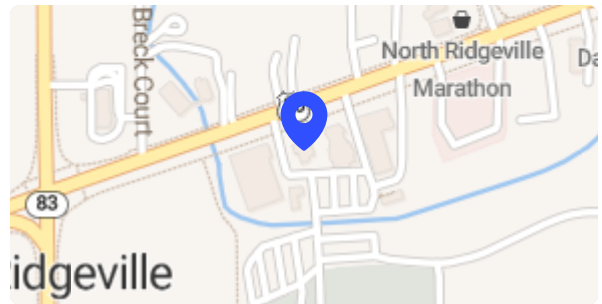

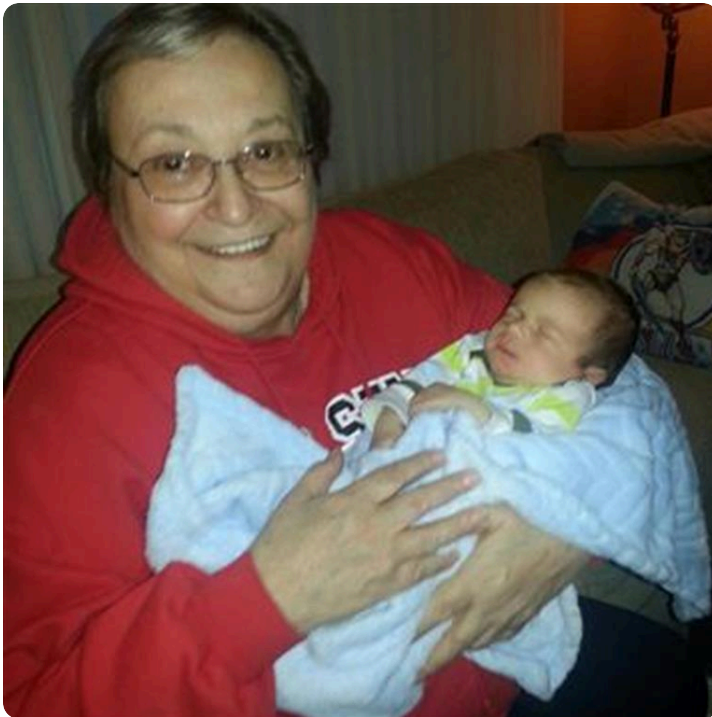
