Lawrence C. "Larry" Schultz, age 71, of North Ridgeville, passed away peacefully on Friday, April 22, 2016 at his home, surrounded by his family.

He was born in Cleveland and had lived in North Ridgeville for the past 45 years.

Larry worked as a mechanic for NASA John Glenn Research Center in Cleveland for 35 years, retiring in 2001.

He enjoyed woodworking, traveling, fishing, cooking, boating, spending time at Kelley's Island and being with his grandchildren.
