**R**aymond J. Tumbry Sr., age 72, of North Ridgeville, passed away on April 30, 2016 at the New Life Hospice Center of St. Joseph in Lorain after a lengthy illness.

He was born on July 16, 1943 in Cleveland and has been a resident of North Ridgeville for the past 48 years. He was a member of St. Peter Catholic Church. He worked on the assembly line for General Motors, retiring in 2006 after 39 years of service.

Raymond enjoyed working on and racing cars at Norwalk Raceway Park and Thompson Drag Raceway. He enjoyed watching NASCAR, NHRA and IHRA drag racing, and the Renegade Racing Association.

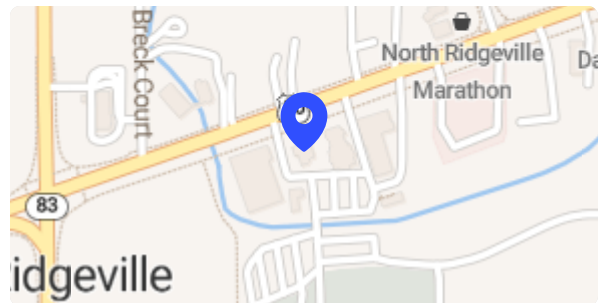

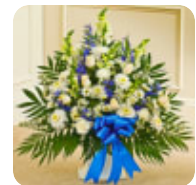
