**W**anda Margaret Jurco (nee Zbydnowski) age 99 of North Ridgeville, passed away peacefully at Life Care Center of Elyria Friday April 17, 2020.

Born in Oberlin, she had resided in North Ridgeville since 1946. She earned an associate degree in Business from Oberlin College.

She was a very active member of St. Peter Church, where she played the organ at daily Mass well into her 90's and was a long-time member of the Altar and Rosary Society. She was dedicated in protecting the unborn, praying and sending letters to the editor of newspapers throughout the country.

Mrs. Jurco Co-Owned and Operated Jurco Farm Market at the corner of Butternut Ridge and Avon Beldon Road in North Ridgeville since 1950. One of her passions was traveling.

Survivors include daughters, Lorraine Glass of Powell, Mary (Larry) Knapp of N. Ridgeville, Margaret (Jayce) Ashwill of Powell, Theresa Jurco D.C. of Encinitas, CA, sons, John (Barbara) of Elyria, James (Victoria) of Palm Harbor, FL and Albert Jurco of Encinitas, CA, 11 grandchildren and 17 great-grandchildren and sister, Dorothy Adams of Miami, FL.
