Anthony Luciano Cioffoletti, age 91, of North Ridgeville, peacefully passed away on Sunday, April 24, 2022 after a sudden illness. He was born on November 18, 1930 in Long Island, New York and was a U.S. Army Veteran of the Korean War. He was a very active member of and past Junior Vice Commander and Honor Guard member at V.F.W. Post 9871, North Ridgeville. He has been a resident of North Ridgeville for the past 28 years, moving from Staten Island. He worked as an Import/Export Manager for D.F. Young, retiring in 1992 after 40 years of service. In his free time, Anthony and his wife Annie enjoyed traveling, concerts, dancing and being with family and friends. Tony was a diehard New York Yankees and Giants fan. He loved to bowl, and was a bowling coach as well as a member of the Staten Island Bowling Hall of Fame. The summer months would find him tending to his garden, pool, and entertaining at home.
