Joseph John Kordek, age 97, of North Ridgeville, passed away on Tuesday, May 3, 2022 at Rae Ann Suburban in Westlake.

He was born in Chicago, Illinois on July 4, 1924 and had been a resident of North Ridgeville since 1957.

He served in the US Army Air Force during WWII and worked as a foreman for Phoenix Dye in Cleveland, retiring in 1989 after 48 years of service.

Joseph was a member of St. Peter Catholic Church in North Ridgeville, Holy Name Society, North Ridgeville VFW Post 9871, United Polish Club, Elyria and American Legion Post 118 in Amherst.

Joe always enjoyed letting people know that they could take the day off for his birthday on July 4th. He also enjoyed bowling and traveling to the casino and playing the slot machines. The summer months would find him fishing, tending to his garden and making wine.
