Bonnie worked as a cafeteria worker at General Motors Parma Chevy Plant, retiring in 2004 after 30 years.

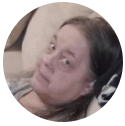

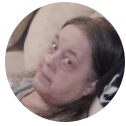
