Nancy A. Kundla (nee Wantig), of Hilliard, formerly of North Ridgeville, passed away on Tuesday, November 7, 2023 at the Riverview Rehabilitation Center in Columbus.

She was born on August 2, 1939 in Bolivia and had been a resident of North Ridgeville for 55 years before moving to Hilliard in 2020. Nancy was a longtime member of St. Peter Church in North Ridgeville, where she was part of the Altar Rosary Society. She was a member of the PTU and a Den Mother for the Girl Scouts. She worked as an aide at St. Peter School in North Ridgeville for many years and had previously worked at Elyria Memorial Hospital and St. John Hospital as a lab technician.

In her free time, Nancy loved knitting, sewing, cooking, watching movies and spending time with her grandchildren.

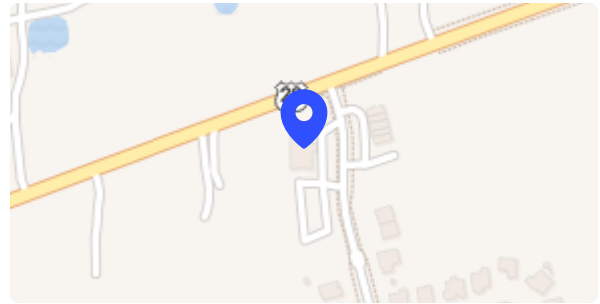

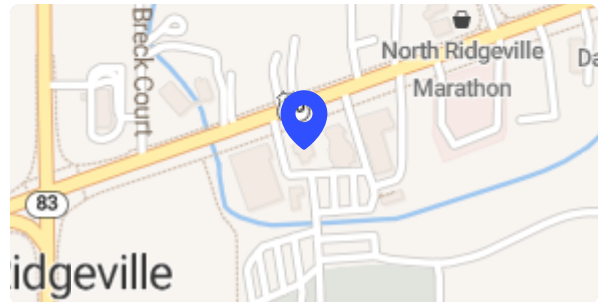
