**B**randon Tyler Weekley, age 31, of Ypsilanti, Michigan, passed away on Thursday, September 5, 2024.

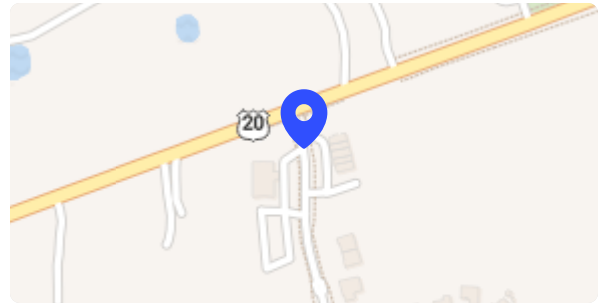
