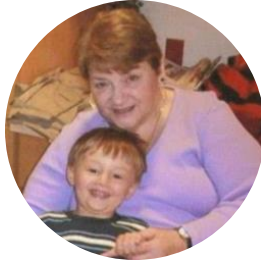

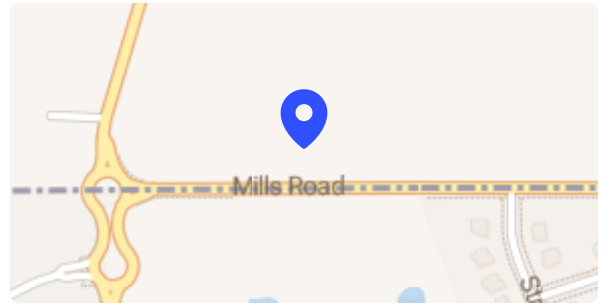

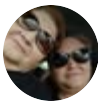


Secretary @ Northeast Ohio Nurse Honor G lit a candle in honor of Susan.
