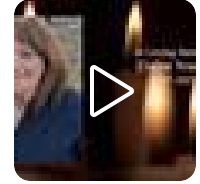

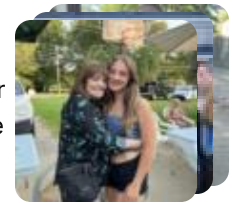
**Michael Faudree** posted:
