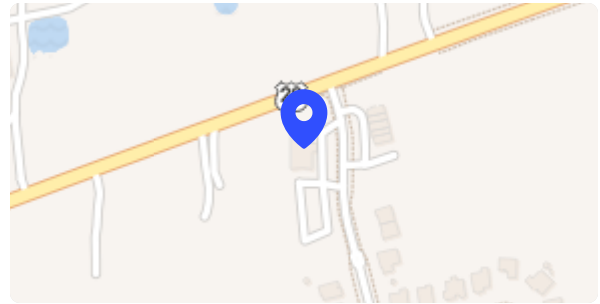
Burial will be in Royalton Road Cemetery, Columbia Twp.

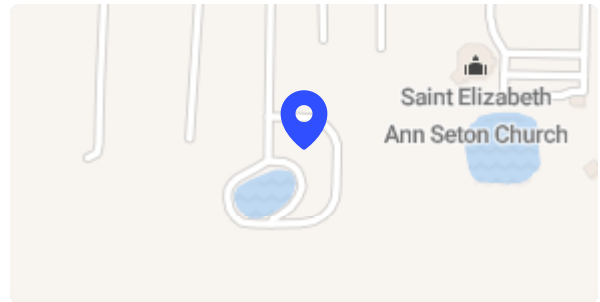

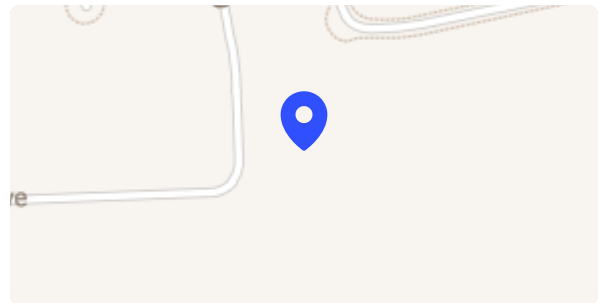
