**C**armen A. Ticconi (nee Spiritosanto), age 71, of Snyder, NY, passed away Monday at Fairview Hospital, Cleveland, Ohio following a long illness. Born in Phillipsburg, PA, she had resided most of her adult life in Snyder, NY. Mrs. Ticconi received her Master of Science in Education from Buffalo State University.

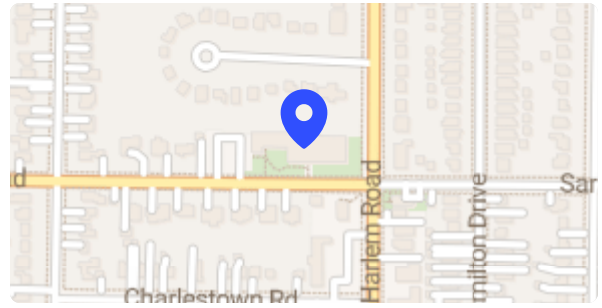
