Agnes B. Yursky (nee Matcho), 87, passed away on April 10, 2012 surrounded by her family at home in North Ridgeville following a long illness.

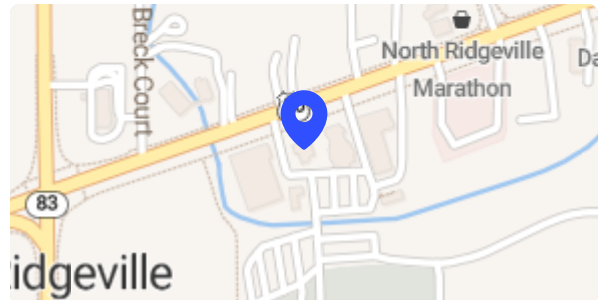
