Michael D. Roscoe, age 64 of Columbia Station passed away peacefully on Tuesday, October 26, 2010 at his residence. He was born in Cleveland, OH and had been a resident of Columbia Station since 2000. He had formerly resided in Rocky River and Lakewood. He had attended Cuyahoga Community College and was a certified EMT/Paramedic. He retired as a Supervisor from the City of Cleveland Water Pollution Control where he served for 36 years. A U.S. Navy veteran, he was a member of St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Catholic Church, Columbia Station and a former member of St. Gregory the Theologian Byzantine Church, Lakewood. Mike enjoyed gardening, hunting and fishing.
