Mark J. Scholtz, 60, passed away on Wednesday, October 6, 2010 at the Cleveland Clinic, after a brief illness. He was born in Cleveland, he had resided in Elyria the past 11 years after moving from Lakewood.

Mr. Scholtz graduated from The Ohio State University and spent his professional career as a "Basic Skills" teacher at St. Mel's, St. Mary Byzantine, St. Jerome and St. Thomas Aquinas Schools, Cleveland, before his retirement in 2009.
