Donald Edward Schroeder, age 81, of Sebring, Florida, passed away Sunday, November 29, 2009 at Hearthland Medical Center in Florida, following a long illness.

Donald served in the US Navy from 1946-1949. He received the American Theater Medal and World War II Victory Medal.
