Susan J. Hronesz, age 58, passed away on March 10, 2009. She was born on April 26, 1950 in Akron, Ohio to Gladys Kathryn and Charles Eugene Shepherd (both deceased). Sue was a resident of North Ridgeville, Ohio, and beloved wife of Bruce Hronesz, a salesman with Sun Chemical. She leaves behind her two children Kristopher Charles Linqvist, who lives in San Jose, California and who is a technologist with Cisco Systems, and Alicia Linqvist, who is presently a teacher with the Peace Corp volunteer in Nkwatia, Ghana, Africa. She also leaves behind her step-children Joe Hronesz and Lou Hronesz, both of Martinsburg, West Virginia and Granddaughter Noelle.
