**T**homas S. Schultz Jr, age 78 of North Ridgeville died Wednesday, February 4, 2009 in University Hospital, Cleveland following a brief illness.

He was born August 7, 1930 in Oak Bluffs, Martha's Vineyard Island, Massachusetts.

He had resided in North Ridgeville the past 44 years after moving from Elyria.

He has been on the North Ridgeville Police Dept. for the past 34 years, starting as the Game Warden, later becoming the Humane Officer. He was a Graduate of the Ohio Police Officers Academy. He also worked as the Welding Foreman for Bendix Corp., in Elyria for many years. Prior to Bendix he was an Air Traffic Controller with the FAA in Oberlin and Burke Lakefront Airport.

Mr. Schultz was a private pilot, having built many of his own planes, was a member of the Civil Air Patrol, the Experimental Aircraft Assoc. The American Model Assoc.. He also enjoyed hunting, scuba diving, fishing, and boating. He was a member of the LaGrange Hunt Club, the NRA, Elyria Elks Club and the F.O.P. Westlake Lodge.

Mr. Schultz served in the US Army Air Corp during the Berlin Air Lift and Korea.

He was a member of St. Mary of the Immaculate Conception Church, Avon.
