Robert L. Miller "Bob", 68 of Elyria, passed away Wednesday January 14, 2009 at the Cleveland Clinic Hospital following a short illness.

Mr. Miller served as a Deacon, Liturgist and usher for the United Church of Christ, Elyria. He had also been a Deacon for the United Church of Christ, Sheffield Lake prior to moving to Elyria. He retired in the late nineties as a store manager for Firestone following thirty years of service. He then kept himself busy by working as a tape cutter for Manco for six years.

Bob Enjoyed bowling on the Sr. bowling league at Brunswick Lanes, North Ridgeville and attending the Elyria Sr. Citizens' Club and functions. He valued time spent with family, and often orchestrated gatherings to get everyone together.
