Edward C. Crawford age 81 of Sheffield Village died Thursday, October 16, 2008 at his residence following a brief illness. He was born in Clay County, WV and had been a resident of Sheffield Village and Sheffield Lake for the past 35 years. He was the owner operator of Ed Crawford Trucking and had also been employed as plant manager for Baker Material & Handling in Cleveland during the 1970's. Mr. Crawford was a U.S. Navy veteran having served as a Seaman 2nd Class in the Pacific Theater during WW II, and was a member of the Sheffield Lake Amvets and a life member of the VFW. He loved hunting and socializing with friends.
