## Oral Robertson

MAR 15, 1921 - MAY 5, 2008

**O**ral Robertson, age 87, of N. Ridgeville, died Monday, May 5, 2008 at Parma Community Hospital, following a long illness.

Mr. Robertson was born in Fort Gay, West Virginia and had lived in N. Ridgeville since 1976. He had also lived in Strongsville and Cleveland.

Mr. Robertson was a member of N. Ridgeville Church of God.

He worked as a set-up man at General Motors, Brookpark, for 31 years before retiring in 1980.

He enjoyed traveling.
