Marian Peepers 73, of Olmsted Twp., died Thursday, July 20, 2006 at Fairview General Hospital following a short illness.

She was born August 29, 1932 in Niagra Falls, Canada, and had lived in Rochester, NY prior to moving to North Ridgeville in 1950.

She was an active member of the Fields United Methodist Church, North Ridgeville. Marian graduated from Baldwin Wallace College in 1954 with a BA in Sociology. She was employed as a substitute teacher for the North Ridgeville City Schools for seventeen years, and had also worked as a medical secretary from 1987- 1997.
