**J**ack B. Fontecchio, age 59 of North Ridgeville, passed away Monday at Metro Health Medical Center, Cleveland, following a long illness. He was born in Erie, Pennsylvania and had been a resident of North Ridgeville since 1977.

Mr. Fontecchio served in the US Army during the Vietnam War.

He received his bachelor's degree in electrical engineering from Gannon University in Erie, Pennsylvania.

He worked as an electrical engineer for the Northeast Ohio Regional Sewer District for the past 12 years.
