Anthony D. Baldassar, age 86, of North Ridgeville, died Monday evening at North Ridge Health Center, North Ridgeville; following a lengthy illness. He was born in Vittorio Veneto, Italy and had been a resident of North Ridgeville since 1975. He previously had lived in Cleveland.

Mr. Baldassar served in the US Army during WWII.
