## **Louis Wysochanski**

**L**ouis P. Wysochanski, age 68 of North Ridgeville, died Saturday, December 18, 2004 at EMH Regional Medical Center, Elyria following a short illness. He was born July 5, 1936 in Monessen, PA. He had raised in North Ridgeville the past 31 years moving from North Olmsted.

Mr. Wysochanski served in the US Air force from 1954 thru 1958.
